### 14. LIFE IN THE WATER

A lot of water is used in the development of workwear, for example in the dyeing process or when using certain chemicals that contains it in order to give the product its protective function. That is why it is of great importance that our suppliers handle the water they use carefully and discharge in a careful matter. There must be properly functioning water purification installations so that no polluted water can end up in open water.
